### SUBMISSION FAQs

**Q: Should I submit a digital and/or a printed copy of my project?**

A: You should email a digital copy of your project to [info@o2italia.org](mailto:info@o2italia.org) by December 15. Only selected participants will be asked to submit printed copies.

**Q: Should I write my name on the poster(s)?**

A: No, but you should include a project title.

**Q: How should I submit the project description?**

A: The project description (up to 600 words) should be submitted as an A4 document. You should include the project title at the top of the page. Do not include your names(s) on this document.

**Q: Can I also include the project description on the A2 poster(s)?**

A: This is optional; you can choose whether or not to include the project description on the A2 poster(s).

**Q: can I submit multiple entries?**

A: Yes you can.

### COMPETITION BACKGROUND FAQs

**Q: Where do beer bottles left in the *Colonne di San Lorenzo* area come from?**

A: The beer bottles left in the *Colonne di San Lorenzo* area are bought from the surrounding bars, pubs and local beverage traders.

**Q: How many bottles are left in the area?**

A: We do not know the approximate number.

**Q: Do people leave other kinds of bottles and cans in the area?**

A: Yes, but most drink containers left in the area are beer bottles.

**Q: Do people also leave drinking glasses in the area?**

A: Yes, people sometimes take their drinks out of the pubs and bars and leave the empty glasses in the area.

**Q: What volume are the beer bottles?**

A: The most common beer bottles consumed in public areas in Milan and other Italian cities are 33cl and 66cl containers.

**Q: When does the problem arise?**

A: The problem arises when the area is full of people during summer nights.

**Q: Does the problem arise on particular days and times?**

A: People start gathering from the *aperitivo* hour around 6-7 pm until the early morning hours. The beer bottle problem arises mostly during summer, on Saturday nights after 9 pm.

**Q: What kind of people usually meet in the area?**

A: Very different groups of people meet in the area, e.g. young people, students, professionals and tourists.

**Q: How many people gather in the area?**

A: We do not know the exact number of people who often gather in the area.

**Q: Are there particular events that take place in the area?**

A: Yes, sometimes during summer nights, outdoor events (such as film screenings) are organized.
